Event	Description	Audience	Attire	Good to Know...
Ice Cream Social	The traditional kick-off for the year, provided by the Parent Organization. Students & parents have the chance to reconnect with friends at this free event. Parents can purchase used school & gym uniforms. Parents can also sign up for volunteer opportunities & learn about after-school activities. Children can meet their classroom teachers, drop off school supplies in the rooms, and sign up for ice cream on Wednesdays. Back to School Night	This is offered on specific days depending on the grade of your child. Parents meet in a classroom with their child's teacher and learn about the classroom expectations, review rules, grading, etc.	Current & New Parents	Dressy Casual	Childcare is provided if needed as long as you RSVP. Children do not come to the classroom with the parents. If you have multiple children, you might need to attend with a spouse/partner/friend to hear from both teachers or schedule a time individually at another time.

This is a great way to spend time with your child, and the teachers really love it.

Awards Day Ceremony	Annual event honoring students and volunteer achievement.	Current Parents, BOT, Foundation Board & Special Guests	Church Attire	Parents are invited if their children are receiving an award, but all parents are welcome. The children also attend field day in the afternoon outside and enjoy bounce houses,
Dad's Day Chapel	Annual event for children in PK - Grade 4 to attend chapel with their fathers or guests.	PK - Grade 4	Church Attire	Special friends or moms are more than welcome in lieu of a father.
SRES Talent Show	This is an opportunity for students to show off their talents with singing, dancing, etc.	All Members of SRES Community	Casual	This can be a longer and hotter event. Dress comfortable! Students must try out in advance of the program.
Alumni Basketball Game	A team of 8th graders face-off in a heated basketball battle against a team of alumni. The capstone of Field Day.	Alumni, Current Parents, Students and Special Guests	Casual	This is a nice way to end Field Day and parents may come early and enjoy ice cream with their children.

Event	Description	Audience	Attire	Good to Know...
All School Assemblies	All of the students & the faculty report to the gym for a speaker, presentation, performance, etc. during the school day.	Primarily for students, but parents are invited	Students are in uniform & parents should wear dressy casual	These typically take place on Friday mornings at 8:15. If your child will have a role or be participating, you will be notified via email.
Honors Breakfast	This is offered three times throughout the year in the gymnasium before school starts at 7:15 to recognize students in grades 5 - 8 who have earned honors or high honors.	Students, Families & Friends	Students are in uniform & parents should wear dressy casual	As long as you are there by 7:30, you should be fine. Breakfast is served by the Parent Organization.
Parents Night Out	This is offered at various times in the year by our aftercare director. Dates/times and activities are typically included in a flyer or Electronic Friday Folder announcements.	Students Only	Students may wear casual attire	This is a great way to take time to go out with other SRES families.
Parent Teacher Conferences	These are offered two times a year, but parents are also encouraged to arrange one at any time by contacting their child's teacher.	Parents Only	Dressy Casual	This is a great opportunity for parents to stay informed and communicate with their child's teacher.
